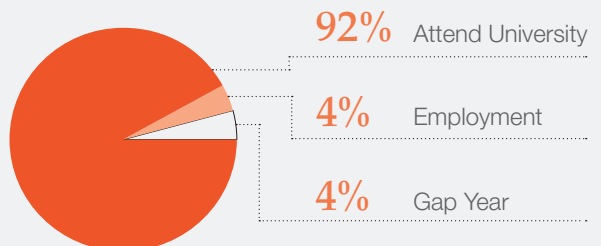

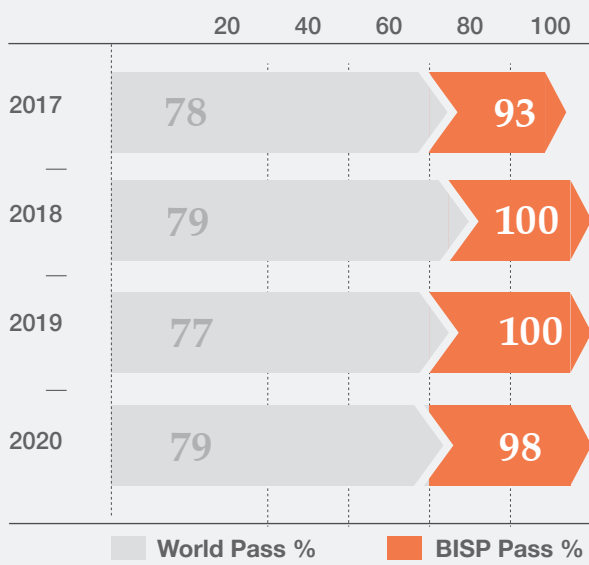
Classes of 2017 - 2020



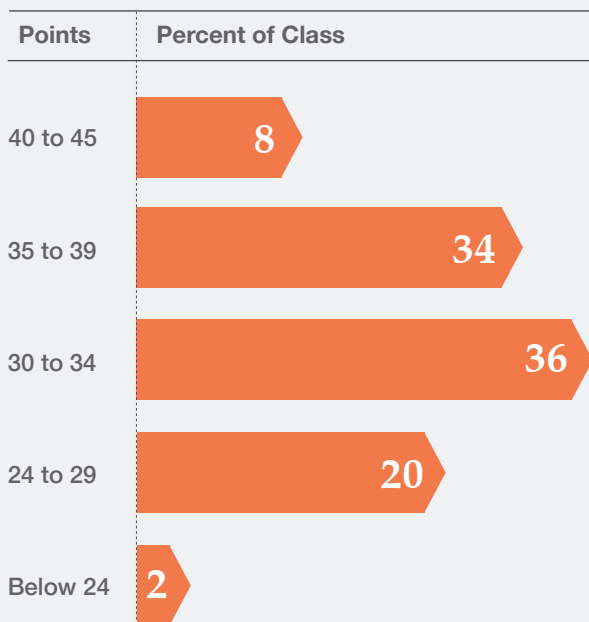
### University Applications

- ♦ No Rank No GPA unless requested by specific university

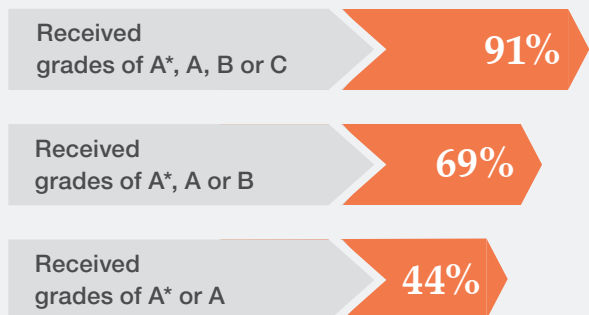
## IB Diploma Pass Rate

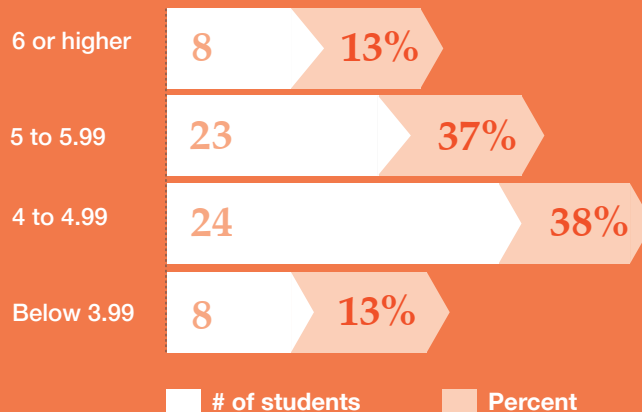
